Pastor Michael began by telling us that the visitation of people in hospitals and nursing homes, which had just begun to open up, is closed again, with few exceptions. For the remaining Sundays in November we will observe Thankoffering and the First Sunday of Advent. Decorating the Sanctuary for Christmas is scheduled for the Saturday morning following Thanksgiving. There is plenty to do and plenty of space to spread out, so please feel free to come and help. There was a lengthy discussion about how to safely hold a Christmas Eve service in these very uncertain times. Since there is no way to predict what will be happening then, several options were discussed. The consensus was that we would like to know who would plan on attending if things are not shut down. Most of our regular, in-person Sunday worship attendees indicated they would plan to be there. So, we will continue this discussion at December's meeting.

We also spent some time discussing our outside groups (scouts, AA & AlAnon) who would all like to come back due to being unable to meet outside with cooler weather. We have agreed to let that happen, implanting state guidelines, along with the group's safety guidelines, and those put in place by Mt. Olivet. Each group will be responsible for cleaning up their specific areas after each use. Of course, all of this hinges on the next response from the governor.

Our financial report was given by Linda. Giving is still down, and we are still waiting for the PPE loan to be forgiven so that she can move that money to the Current Expense account. Bills are paid and \$500 was sent to Christina House from Benevolence. Please remember the church during this difficult time. Tina T. is planning to start the Grief Group on Saturday Nov. 21 at 10 am. Again, this is following all the safety protocols that are in place at that time. This will be a great comfort to people during this difficult season. Thank you to Tina for recognizing the need and the courage to get it started.

I also want to say thank you to Tammie Jones for being so motivated to keep Sunday School going for ALL ages now. Her driving force has been unwavering, and we are all benefitting from her dedication. Music has also been exceptionally welcome during this unsettling time. It has been great to hear the 'choir', as well as the new music from the Contemporary Team. It puts a touch of normal back into our uncertain lives.

And, last but not least, thanks to Pastor Michael for his teachings about the life of the Apostle Paul. God was there for Paul in all his difficult trials and God is there for us, too. 
